

Diocesan Advisory Committee Notification of Advice

This notification constitutes advice only and does not give you permission to carry out the works or other proposals to which it relates. A faculty must be obtained from the court before the works or proposals may lawfully be carried out.

In the diocese of Lichfield Parish of Tutbury Church of Tutbury S. Mary the Virgin

The church is not listed under the Planning (Listed Buildings and Conservation Areas) Act 1990. At a meeting of the Diocesan Advisory Committee held on 12/04/2016, the following works or other proposals were considered:

Installation of two wreath holders near to the War Memorial (in the churchyard).

The Committee **RECOMMENDS** the works or proposals for approval by the court:

The DAC commented:

*The Archdeacon and DAC Secretary had attended a site meeting with the Tutbury War Memorials Preservation Committee and the PCC; the Archdeacon outlined the revised proposals presented at that meeting. Members were not entirely convinced that the proposed design was the most appropriate for the curtilage of a grade 1 listed building but accepted that, for practical reasons, the PCC required a wreath holder and that the applicants had tried to develop the design as best they could with limited resources; members were also conscious that much time and effort had been expended by the Tutbury War Memorials Preservation Committee in conserving the War Memorial to the benefit of both the memorial and the setting of the church. In the circumstances and given the support of the Archdeacon for the proposals, they were prepared to recommend the scheme to the Chancellor. **Their preferred option was number 2 but without the finial to the top rail and this was the only option that they were supporting.***

This advice does not constitute authority for carrying out the works or proposals and a faculty is required

In the opinion of the Committee the work or part of the work proposed is NOT likely to affect

- the character of the church as a building of special architectural or historic interest
- the archaeological importance of the building
- archaeological remains existing within the church or its curtilage

In the opinion of the Committee rule 9.9 of the Faculty Jurisdiction Rules (publication of notice on diocesan website) applies / does NOT apply to the works or proposals

The Committee recommends that the intending applicants consult such of the bodies or persons: - Historic England (West Midlands)
