Dear Miss Higginbotham

Thank you for your email.

Only three of the photographs are 2009 (taken early in the morning after Remembrance Day), those of the bronze plaques which are, according to the church architect, considered to be in good condition (easily readable with a good patina).

The rest were all taken in March 2012, when we started to lobby (unsuccessfully) the Parish Council to conserve the War Memorial; this failure resulted in the creation of the War Memorial Preservation Committee to take on the task. The photographs were provided in the form of a web album to Emma Suckling (then Nelson) in April last year to confirm that the memorial needed "attention", which confirmation was subsequently forthcoming; we are effectively resubmitting what the WMT has already seen.

The 33 photographs are all high quality (4MB or more each) to enable the detail of the problems to be readily observed e.g.



- Are photographs from March 2012 recent enough (nothing has improved since then)? If not, then I will have to go and re-photograph the memorial, but the photographs will look stunningly similar.
- If you prefer to receive the photographs via email, what is the minimum quality (photograph size KB) that is acceptable - if the quality is not of concern to the WMT at this stage, then I would like to only convert these photographs once and send as few emails as possible. Alternatively, as the photos are too large to send two at a time (which would be >8MB) then it would be 30+ emails.

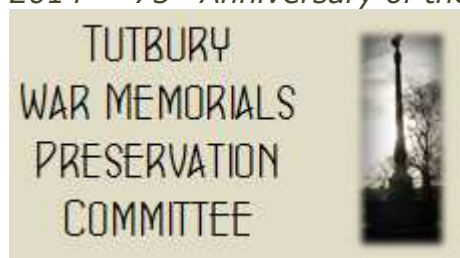
