## WREATH HOLDER LANDSCAPING MEETING – 15 FEB 2018

Topics for the meeting as follows:

### **1) Define the area to be landscaped**

Primary objective of the landscaping is to protect the Wreath Holders from the towed mower and strimmers of the Parish Council contractor – i.e. defensive landscaping. Faculty says 600mm (2ft) wide gravel bed.

### **2) Form of landscaping**

Gravel, chippings, paving (slabs, block) or anything else anyone can think of – all suggestions welcome. Gravel is liable to be thrown up by strimmers and cause damage. Faculty specifies gravel!

### **3) Edging of the landscaped area** (applicable to loose material fill)

- c) Dispose of waste
- d) Prepare soil
- e) Obtain materials
- f) Lay weed blanket?
- g) Cutting pavers
- h) Lay gravel or pavers
